

Instructions for starting the Self-Paced Learning via “Bowls Learn”

1. Enter the website address learn.bowls.com.au into your web browser. Google Chrome is the preferred browser.
2. In the top right hand corner select the login button.

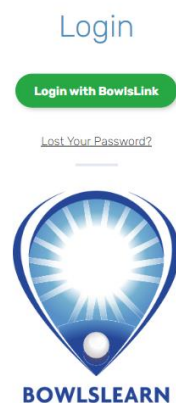
BowlsLearn provides a method of completing self-paced bowls-related training in a range of areas including:

- Officiating
- Coaching
- BowlsLink
- Program Coordination

BowlsLearn is a training platform that largely replicates what is offered in-person in the Coaching and Officiating areas. Please note that to fully complete some courses/modules (e.g. Club Coach, Markers, Measurers, National Umpires), there will be an on-green component that will be required to be completed at the conclusion of the self-paced learning component.

3. If you already have your Bowls Link login details select **Login with BowlsLink** login then go to step 5. If not select **Lost Your Password?**



4. To recover your password enter your Email and select **RECOVER PASSWORD** – this must match what has been recorded in Bowls Link. You will receive an automated email with 5 minutes – please check your junk or spam filters.

- Under the 'Officiating' heading there are three Modules available. If you have applied to accredit or reaccredit as a National Umpire, please complete all three Officiating modules. If accrediting or reaccrediting as a Marker and/or Measurer only, just complete the relevant module(s).
- To complete a module click on the desired one and TAKE THIS COURSE. Read all the instructions; select CURRICULUM and scroll down to Course Content. Your progress will be recorded as you go.

One method of becoming a certified Bowls Marker is to complete this self-paced training, along with an on-green component to be organised through your State/Territory Association. Marker is a nationally recognised qualification issued by Bowls Australia and State/Territory Associations.
